Place: Community Room of the Bass Pro Shops in Pearl, MS

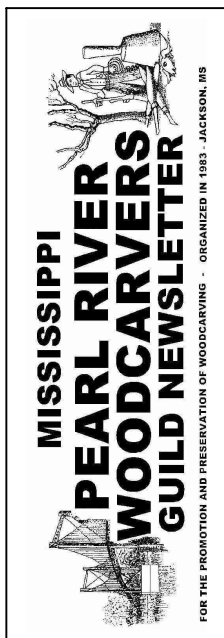
PROGRAM: Don Rinehart will do a demonstration on wood carving feathers.
